Introduction

Creative Central NCL is partnering with Northern Pride and Curious Arts for Pride in the City 2024 to **fund four Research & Development Get Ready grants**, that include creative sector mentoring opportunities, and producer support for the commissioned creatives.

Pride in the City, under the theme **Unapologetically Visible**, takes over Newcastle City centre in a new format this year, celebrating the vibrant and beautiful queer community, the valuable impact they have on society and the richness of their talents, from makers and creators to performers and activists.

Pride in the City takes place across Newcastle City centre, including in the Creative Central NCL footprint.

Activities start on 8 July and culminate in the Pride Festival weekend of 19 – 21 July 2024.

What are we looking for?

We're looking for applications from creatives and artists who want to showcase their work or ideas during the Pride in the City campaign. We'll support four Get Ready grants for you to create new work or develop, elevate and enhance existing ideas.

We will consider ideas for work in any art form, including, but not limited to:

- visual artwork
- performance such as dance, theatre, music and spoken word,
- installations and exhibitions,
- comedy,
- podcasts or digital media.

Your idea must include a public-facing output, sharing, performance opportunity, or event that can be showcased during Pride in the City in a venue in Creative Central NCL.

This could be a finished product (especially if this grant is enhancing an existing project or idea) or a scratch or a discussion, depending on what's appropriate to your idea.

Criteria

All ideas submitted must consider and respond to the theme

Unapologetically Visible:

What this means to you and how you express and explore it is subjective, and creative interpretations and responses are welcomed.

At Northern Pride, being Unapologetically Visible signifies our refusal to be silenced or diminish ourselves in any way. Being unapologetically you for the LGBTQIA+ community means becoming conscious of the pursuit of yourself, stripping back all the layers of who society taught you to be, and truly opening up to your true authentic self.

In the journey of becoming unapologetic, LGBTQIA+ people aren't becoming someone different, but they no longer feel the need to hide or be who other people want them to be, and it's about no longer holding back from fully expressing ourselves due to the fear of being judged.

Ideas submitted for consideration must fulfil at least one of the following criteria:

1. Explores Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, Intersex, Asexual + (LGBTQIA+) and/or gender themes.
2. Is of interest to LGBTQIA+ communities.
3. Is created or presented by LGBTQIA+ Artists.
4. Is a clear development opportunity for the Artist.

Creative Central NCL, Northern Pride and Curious Arts welcome applications from all sections of the community.

We're particularly keen to encourage applications from people who are often underrepresented in the creative sector, especially artists and creatives from the LGBTQIA+ community.

Support and Budget

Selected artists will receive the following support.

- A £750 R&D Get Ready Grant
- A 60-minute session with a Curious Arts producer to support the development of your work/idea
- A 60-minute 1-2-1 session with a mentor who is matched to your idea/art form from Queer Arts North network (mentors will be matched to you)
- A meet-up and networking opportunity with the cohort of commissioned Artists and stakeholders
- Promotion within the Pride in the City print and digital programme
- Promotion across Northern Pride, Curious Arts and Creative Central NCL social platforms and associated comms activities (press releases, etc)
- In-kind venue support for your performance or event during the festival (and support to source in-kind or low-cost rehearsal space if required in the development of your work)

Applications

All applications should be received by 11:59pm on Sunday 12 May 2024.

Applications* should be equivalent to 1 side of A4 in total or a maximum 2 minute audio/video recording, and include:

- A brief artist bio
- Links to your previous work/portfolio
- A summary of your idea and how it responds to the theme Unapologetically Visible
- A summary of how the £750 grant would be spent to support your idea (this could be a simple table or separate excel spreadsheet)

If selected, you will be asked to provide:

- A copy of your Public Liability Insurance, you **do not** have to provide this as part of your application.
- Any risk assessments applicable to the sharing of your work, the Pride in the City team can support you with this.
